

Information regarding the Tohoku Earthquake

(Notification No.9 March 29, 2011)

(Temporary Suspension in Accepting Donations of Relief Supplies)

First of all, we would like to thank you for your cooperation and for your generosity towards the victims of the Tohoku Earthquake.

Here at the prefectural office, we have received many supplies from residents through local city and town offices, and have been continuously sending them along to affected areas. However, due to the large amount of supplies received, we are currently unable to send all collected supplies. Therefore, as of the 3rd of April, we will temporary suspend the collection of supplies at reception desks in city and town offices.
